**ESSENTIALITY CERTIFICATE**

In Continuation of the Essentialty Certificate no.3075/71-3-07-N-7/2007, dated 20-8-2007 & Essentialty Certificate no.4588/71-3-07-N-7/2007, dated 28-11-2007 the desired certificate is as follows:-

- (1) No. of Institutions already existing in the State: One Medical University "Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University Lucknow", 07 State medical colleges & 06 private medical colleges. M.D/M.S. Courses are running in the "Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University Lucknow, 06 State medical college & Santoshi medical college, Ghaziabad.
- (2) No. of seats available or No. of doctors being produced annually: 1162 in Medical and 2060 in Dental Colleges.
- (3) No. of doctors registered with the State Medical Council : 51279
- (4) No. of doctors in Government service : 12000 in PMHS and 750 in Medical Colleges.
- (5) No. of Government posts vacant and those in rural/difficult areas : Related to Medical Health Department.
- (6) No. of doctors registered with Employment Exchange : No registration in Employment Exchange. Doctors registration are done in State Medical and Dental Faculty, U.P.
- (7) Doctor population ratio in the State : One doctor on 3456 population (considering No. registered and current population as census-2001).
- (8) How the establishment of the college would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the State and improve the availability of such medical manpower in the State : Majority of doctors who qualify is likely to stay in the state.
- (9) The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any, on students who are not domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in the State be specified: Candidate must be domicile for state quota seats only.
- (10) Full justification for opening of the proposed college : to improve doctor population ratio.

(11) Doctor-patient ratio proposed to be achieved : One Medical College of 100 intake capacity per crore of population.

The Saraswathi Ammal Educational and Charitable Trust, Annanagar, Chennai has applied for establishment of a medical college at N.H. 24, Vill. Anwarpur, Hapur, Distt. Ghaziabad (U.P.). On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Uttar Pradesh has decided to issue an essentiality certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a Medical College with 150 (no.) seats.

It is certified that:-

(a) The applicant owns and manages a 300 bedded hospital which was established in the year 2007.

(b) It is desirable to establish a medical college in the public interest.

(c) Establishment of a medical college at Ghaziabad by Saraswathi Ammal Educational and Charitable Trust, Annanagar, Chennai, is feasible.

(d) Adequate clinical material as per the Medical Council of India norms is available.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the medical college as per MCI norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.
