 - (iii) No student should be admitted in the above college till the formal permission of Central Govt. is granted.
 - (iv) The applicant should provide a Bank Guarantee of Rs.7.00 crores (Rupees 1.50 crores towards medical college and 5.50 crores towards hospital facilities) valid for five years from a Nationalized/Scheduled Bank as per the norms of the Medical Council of India.

4. Action to grant formal permission of the Central Govt. for starting of a new medical college at Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh by your Trust will be initiated on receipt of a compliance letter fulfilling the conditions enumerated in the paragraph 3 above.




